This term, year 3 have travelled back in time to learn about the Ancient Greeks. We have studied what it was like to be a citizen of Ancient Greece, to take part in the sporting events of the ancient Olympic games and discover the many qualities of the heroes and heroines of Greek mythology.

As part of our design and technology learning, we have designed and constructed a castle out of card using 3d nets. At times, the hexagonal pyramids did get the better of us, but with great perseverance we have some amazing structures – some have even been attacked by dragons!

In our English learning, we have used a beautiful book called Cloud Tea Monkeys to write a report about tea. The children had a great time being chief tea tasters and sampled lots of different flavours of tea. The most popular was the red berry tea, this smelt divine! We researched many facts about tea and the children wrote a wonderful report outlining where and how tea is grown.

Finally, we hit Broadway and enjoyed reading poems by the poet T. S. Eliot; these feature in the Cats musical. We spent weeks analysing the different cat characters and finding out about their unique personalities. During these sessions we watched some of the video clips from the musical itself to really bring the poems to life. It was great fun and lovely to hear the children humming the songs during the day.
